St. Regis Father Shield's Club Room Kitchen to undergo complete renovation in June.

The Father Shield's Club Room kitchen will undergo a complete renovation this summer. The renovation is scheduled to commence in June after the SOS event. This renovation will bring the kitchen up to current state and health department codes required for re-heating pre-cooked and frozen foods. The kitchen will also be greatly improved with new appliances, countertops and cabinets and more.

The Women of St. Regis initiated the project and hired a commercial kitchen consultant to guide us in our choices and our options for the renovation.



Renovation plans include a complete tear out of the existing kitchen. The cement floor will be cut to allow for installation of new plumbing to meet State and Health Department codes. Installation includes a new 3 compartment sink and a hand washing sink, new water heater, new microwave, new washable ceiling tiles, stainless steel counter tops and back splash, new maple cabinets, new ice machine and a new commercial convection warming/heating oven that meets the regulations of the State and Health Departments.

Renovation will begin after SOS on June 29, 2009 and is scheduled for completion in September 2009. There are multiple opportunities we may realize with the renovation of the FSCR kitchen.



With the large variety of frozen foods available on the market now, there are more options to expand the meal offerings for school lunches as well as other events which utilize the kitchen for serving large crowds.
